Cllr. Verrinder invited questions from the members of the public that were present.

All four members of the public wished to speak regarding their interest in Planning Application numbers A/110/19/HH and A/122/19/OUT.

Regarding A/110/19/HH - the member of the public talked through what they would like to achieve and confirmed that windows, design, material etc. would be in keeping with what was already present. Cllr. Oldfield wanted to confirm the exact location, which he did. Once the committee had made its decision the member of the public thanked the committee and left the meeting.

Regarding A/122/19/OUT - three members of the public wanted to raise their concerns regarding their private driveway as they were concerned that the - MIDIN

Discussions also took place regarding the existing footpath, general access, schooling and some concerns over the potential volume of traffic. It was explained that the Highways authorities will be considering the implications of the proposal. Regarding schooling it was explained that a site for a three form entry primary school had been identified in the Mayflower park which would involve a land swap with West Sussex County Council (WSCC).
