DECISION: Objection

Angmering Parish Council was opposed to this proposal when it was put forward in the Arun Development Plan. We now object to this revised application which does nothing to address our concerns expressed in our previous objection

The infrastructure within the village is inadequate to support this proposal. This and none of the other strategic developments have included measures to substantially improve traffic conditions in the narrow roads through the village. Entry to Dappers Lane from the north is denied as the A27 Underpass is one way - south to north Blockages, congestion and inconvenience to residents will inevitably increase as a result of this proposal. From a planning point of view it will have an adverse impact on the surrounding area and raise issues over Highway Safety

COMMENT:

If Arun District Council is minded to approve this Development, we would ask the following to be taken into account and catered for.

- The proposal includes the provision of a length of footway in Dappers Lane and provisions in other developments would result in a footway over the whole length of Dappers Lane from this site to Water Lane.
 - In the event of any of these other developments not materialising it should be conditional that the developer of this proposal be required to construct the missing lengths or provide a financial contribution for doing so.
- 2. It is apparent that there may be difficulties with the foul and surface water drainage from the site.

It should be conditional that both should be fully designed and approved by the relevant Authorities before any commencement of

work. The design should specifically take into account the capacity and structural integrity of existing foul and surface water sewers, drains, culverts and watercourses
