#### **Angmering Twinning Association Planter**

The Angmering Twinning Association have a planter located on the Village Square, this was installed in July 2016 for the Twinning Association's  $40^{th}$  anniversary. Angmering Parish Council currently pay £7617 to maintain beds and planters, this particular unit will cost an additional amount of £242.71 on an annual basis with the current contractors.

#### St Peter and St Paul Annual Fair, Saturday 1st July 2017.

The St Peter and St Paul Annual Fair preparations are going well with a variety of stallholders, Huxley's Birds of Prey and Sompting Morris Dancers all confirmed. The fair has been advertised in the Parish Council noticeboards, on social media pages, the Parish Council Window and the All about Angmering magazine. The Annual Fair leaflets have been distributed to St Wilfrid's and St Margaret's Schools and are available in many of the shops in the village centre.

#### Skatebowl and BMX Jam 2017

The BMX event started in September 2015 with a promotional open day for the newly constructed BMX Track, this event was run by the contractors of the BMX Track build and was a successful day. 2016 saw an event which covered both the skatebowl and the BMX Track with each being run by separate organisations. Members of staff from the Parish Council office had a large workload in organising the 2016 event with many communication problems with the organisations running the events and with the event on the day, with staff members and councillors performing tasks that were not considered to be part of the arrangement.

Again there has been difficulty with communication and other lines of enquiry have been undertaken. S N Jenks, who ran the 2015 Promotional Open Day has said that the Angmering Track is a pump BMX Track and is not suitable to hold National or Regional races. He will write and confirm the reasons.

Due to the nature of the event and that professionals are needed to run the event, Councillors are asked to consider not holding the event this year and to hold it every 2 years for the future.
