Two members of the public spoke at length regarding planning application number A/122/19/OUT. Cllr.Hamilton-Street spoke regarding Palmer Road Sports facilities, specifically being identified in the Neighborhood Plan in 2016 as a site that needs to be developed because of its bad state of repair and the need to increase the leisure use by children and their families.

A member of the public gave a comprehensive assessment of the proposed development and inquired if an assessment and viability study has been done on the current land housing the sports facilities. It was also suggested that the applications for the Sports Hub and the housing be separate applications or considered as a whole, both the housing portion and the sports facilities. Cllr. Oldfield will follow this up with Michael Eastham at Arun District Council. Additionally, there was an enquiry about the amount of 106 monies currently held by Arun District Council for the sports facilities. Cllr. Oldfiled has been assured at a meeting earlier today that there is sufficient funding.

A member of the public spoke about concerns regarding the increased traffic and the junction A27 west to Arundel, Cllr. Oldfield spoke briefly on that there is a report due from West Sussex Highways imminently.
