Don't tolerate anti-social driving – report it!

Anti-social driving includes driving that is careless, deliberately aggressive or dangerous. For example:

- speeding
- thoughtless driving
- underage driving
- drink or drug driving
- mobile phone use
- unlicenced or uninsured driving
- driving without a seatbelt
- untaxed or unsafe vehicles

You'll need to tell us:

- 1. About the vehicle the colour, make, model and number plate
- 2. Where the incident happened including any house numbers, road names, shops or local landmarks that help narrow it down
- 3. What happened what you saw or experienced

Always make sure you pull over in a safe place to make any notes – or ask a passenger to record the details.

What happens when you report anti-social driving to Crackdown?

That depends on the incident. The details you provide will be kept on our database; some reports lead to arrest and prosecution. It is **always** worth making a report. Working together, we can crack down on anti-social driving and make Sussex roads safer.
