This is a very major development on a site in Angmering that is known to flood, and this has proved to be a major factor in the flooding of the village in the past. It is essential that an assessment is carried out by Arun drainage engineers or independent consultants before approval can be given to this condition. Phasing of work on this development should be also designed to ensure that drainage to the Black Ditch is not increased from its present level until all surface water drainage elements are completed to ensure that the Ditch is not overwhelmed in flood conditions.

Condition 30 Discharge flow to watercourses Cannot be approved until assessed by Arun drainage engineers

Cllr. Verrinder advised that there were no updates and APC we are still waiting for the survey to Angmering Residents to be published and the result of that before the draft assessment is forwarded to ADC and the Conservation Officer.

Arun District Conservation Area Advisory Panel (ADCAAP) met again after an enforced break of 30 months on Friday, as part of their remit the meeting was informed that APC were embarking on extending their CA. It was also confirmed that Martyn White will now work fully on Conservations Matters as the ADC Conservation Officer. ADCAAP is also calling for more people to join the panel. It transpires that Enforcement and Compliance are having a problem without an Enforcement Officer, which means we may have a problem getting things done.



ADCAAP is planning an assessment of Angmering on Wednesday 19th October anyone wishing to join the panel they will be meeting outside the Lamb at 1400hrs

After the report was read out no comments were made.

# 13 22/088 SOUTH DOWNS NATIONAL PARK

Cllr. Verrinder reported the following:

The SDNP Local Plan Review consultation calling for sites and open green spaces closed on 28th September. Awaiting the result of this consultation – needless to say we need to be aware of any calls made regarding Angmering Park and other land within our national park boundaries.

SDNP Town & Parish Council Workshop – Cllr. Verrinder will be attending this at Midhurst on Tuesday 18th Oct agenda received.

SDNP – Equestrian TAN – Please read as Angmering does have equestrian areas within its boundary and this may affect them. This consultation will be responded to by APC.

#### 14 22/089 COMPLIANCE

Cllr. Verrinder reported that there are reports that construction workers of the BDW – Ecclesden Park development are using the car park by the bridge over the A280. This has been reported direct to BDW and they have assured us they will take action.

### 15 22/090 APPEALS

The following updates were given:

- Still awaiting the decision on the Rustington Golf Centre.
- We are still waiting for the next step for development on the old Chandlers BMW site, Water Lane.

#### 16 22/091 CORRESPONDENCE

An e-mail has been received from the Leader of the "Save Dappers Lane" group drawing our attention to a request for a meeting with WSCC and our MP as the petition for a "no through road closure" of Dappers Lane (access only) has reached approx. 900 signatures. We await the outcome of this.

They are also asking for a meeting with WSCC and Angmering's MP, Andrew Griffiths.

### 17 22/092 HIGHWAYS MATTERS

**Survey** - In an effort to understand more about the type of public transport that serves Angmering and the transport needs of the residents of Angmering, APC are currently undertaking a Transport Survey to find out the opinions and needs of the Parish residents. This survey is now live and can be found on the APC website, APC Facebook page and advertised in our office window and noticeboards. So far 100 responses have been submitted.

**A259** – The September update has been received and will be posted to our Facebook page. This whole construction is due for completion now in December 2022



**WSCC Highways** – There is a lot of information regarding highways matters coming from WSCC which may have an effect on Angmering, particularly relating to: -

- Bus it
- Bus Services Improvement Plan
- Review of the Highway Improvement Programme
- WSCC Response to the Consultation by Transport for Southeast on a Draft Strategic Investment Plan
- Review of the Integrated Parking Strategy 2022-2027

Cycle Path Working Group — Cllr. Verrinder commented that at a previous meeting it was agreed to create a small working group to map cycle paths in the village and investigate the provision of more for the infrastructure plan. Volunteers were called for and Cllr Alan Evans and Mike Watson of the Angmering Cycle Club have expressed a very keen interest in this project, however more members are needed. Due to other commitments, it will not be possible for members of P&I to take part. This is being taken to Full Council for discussion on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022.
