At Full Council, Councillor Andy Cooper alluded to the formation of a Flooding Forum, Councillor Bicknell is tonight attending this Meeting. As Flooding is part of the P&I Terms of Reference. I would ask that ClIr Bicknell to report back to P&I on the outcome.

ADC Local Plan – I have been asked to attend a workshop called "Direction of Travel Document" at ADC on 5th December 2023. The Direction of Travel document has been produced by Arun District Council to seek views in preparing a new Local Plan for Arun District. This is an exciting opportunity for people to tell us what should be included in the Local Plan right at the start before the Plan has been put together. It will be an important plan because it will need to set out the council's aspirations and community needs for the next 20 years at a time of significant change, including the serious challenges of tackling Climate Change. The document will be going to the Planning Policy Committee on 28 November 2023 and will be published along with the agenda on the ADC website. Th document can be read at https://www.arun.gov.uk/arun-local-plan-update-2023-2041. This is an 80-page document which I hope you will spare some time to read and make comments. If you are able, please watch the webcast on the 28th November.

I am also attending two NALC workshops by Zoom: -

"Making the planning system work for Local Councils" 22nd December 2023 – I will report back at the next P&I meeting on 12th December 2023 "How Local Councils can benefit from the Levelling up Agenda" 31st January 2024. There is still time to register for this workshop, please speak to Katie.

It has been suggested that some sort of workshop should be held by ADC or a another to include all Local Councils within ADC to explain the Levelling-Up process and what is expected of Local Councils. What are your feelings? Would Angmering benefit from this sort of workshop. Should APC instigate the first move. The Clerk is in discussion with our Planning Consultant on this.

Just come through, NALC are also holding a workshop on 27th March 2024 "Reconnecting Communities through Community Transport". As Angmering does have a problem with public transport, please contact Katie if you are interested in attending this workshop.

As you know by now Application A/11/23/PL (Chandler Site) has been approved. Because of its location, this is one development, with the possible disruption it could cause to the Square, that we must keep an eye on throughout the whole construction period, therefore please familiarize yourselves with the Decisions made by ADC and report any infringements to ADC. We need to ensure that no demolition/construction work is begun before the Construction Management Plan has been received and Approved by ADC. When we do receive the CMP Application, we must ensure it has no adverse impact on movement within Angmering.



Three Applications have been withdrawn: -

Two applications A/185/23 and A/186/23 relating to Garden House has been withdrawn – this concerned the remodelling of the building next door to include kitchen and store with bi-folding doors.

Cllr Marsh said that Developers on all the sites within Angmering are still not complying with their Construction Management Plans to ensure that mud etc is not laid down on the public highway or footpaths. This is especially a concern on the developments at Golfers Lane and High Street, Angmering.

16 23/159 CORRESPONDENCE

- a) Correspondence has been received for the Stopping Up and Diversion Order 2023 regarding Footpath 2149 North of Water Lane (Langmead Place). Councillors stated that they thought the diversion of this footpath made sense and therefore had no adverse comment to make.
- b) A copy of a letter from Persimmon has been forwarded to APC regarding the fencing to Garden Close and Woodlands Close in which Persimmon offer the residents three options one to erect fencing abutting the existing fencing, two remove and replace fencing or three to leave the garden open to the development site. We await the residents' decision and if another NMA application will be sent by Persimmon. The previous application was withdrawn because ADC advised Persimmon that they didn't consider the application to be a NMA.
- c) Three Correspondence from a local Resident –
- i commenting on the latest proposal from Persimmon regarding the fencing on Herons Park with Garden Close and Woodlands Close
- ii raising concerns over the drainage and flooding issues with various applications
- iii raising concerns over the walking and cycling connections within Angmering
- d) Correspondence has been received from Aldingbourne Parish Council raising grave concerns over ADC's management and control of its Strategic Development programmes. They have sent a letter and a report to ADC. The report has been written by our own Planning Consultant.
- e) Kingston Parish Council has notified APC that the developer for the site in Kingston which was previously refused by ADC has re-applied (K/46/23/PL) and are asking for comments on the latest application. P&I are happy for APC to reply as it previously did. Councillors are asked to view this application and make any comments to Katie.
