Cllr. Verrinder read out her report as follows:

WSCC EV ChargePoint Roll Out – on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 County launched 1. its plans for installing and maintaining thousands of these across the County. This must be monitored in respect of Angmering, and I would like a Councillor to take on this project.

After a short discussion as to if this should be an APC project Cllr. Hobson commented that she felt people needed to be encouraged to use electric vehicles and would like to take a look into this further, this was agreed.

Notice has been received that the application A/256/21/RES – Land North of Water Lane is to be heard at the ADC Council Chambers on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at 1400hrs. All are welcomed to attend. Anyone wishing to say anything must formally register their wish no later than 0900 on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022. Ian Johnson of Lukenbeck has sent a briefing note summarising the reserved matters application, main changes made in response to consultee comments and the key benefits of the proposal

Cllr. N Hamilton-Street is unable to attend this meeting and therefore councillors were asked to attend if possible. Cllr. Oldfield raised various points and it was agreed that Cllr. N Hamilton-Street will write to Neil Crowther and ask that this item be removed from the meeting.

Angmering's Flood Alleviation Scheme There was to have been a workshop with West Sussex Lead Local Flood Authority on 5<sup>th</sup> May, this was cancelled, however, we at Angmering were not invited or even made aware of this meeting. Ray Drabble was informed of this by Geoff Gibbs and his reply to Geoff was that he thought Geoff was a Councillor. Cllr. Nikki Hamilton-Street has been sent the invite to attend.
- 6. The **Arun County Local Forum** took place on 20<sup>th</sup> June at which an Angmering resident attended and asked questions relating to Bus Shelters, Cycle Paths, and Toilets

- 7. **Dappers Lane**, by now you should all have received the photograph of the work WSCC has done changing the lay out of the junction with the Old Arundel Road. Hopefully this will stop any more infringements of the law.
- 8. The South Downs National Park are holding a **webinar on Climate Change** on 13<sup>th</sup> July 18:30-20:00. As Climate Change is now a major issue, I shall attend this. If anyone else wishes to attend, please contact Sam in the office for the connection details.

Kingston Parish Council has requested help with a planning objection they wish to raise. Cllr. Hamilton-Street gave some background to this application/objection and all agreed that APC should help, assist where we possible.

Cllr. Verrinder also advised that she has been invited to attend a meeting with East Preston Parish Council regarding the No: 12 bus route and she would report back. Cllr. N Hamilton-Steet and Cllr. Oldfield commented that this had been discussed before and that this would involve a large financial commitment from APC.

Cllr. Verrinder then referred to the Action List and the outstanding action for Cllr. Bicknell. As Cllr. Bicknell was not present an email will be sent to advise an update is needed.

# Chairs Report 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2022 Agenda Item 5

- 1) No 12 Bus Route I attended a meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> July at East Preston Parish Council Offices with regard to extending this service into Angmering. Although Rustington and East Preston are committed to this route and proposed extension, Angmering cannot commit until it knows if there is a need for this service which will include, Angmering Station, Littlehampton Beach and Leisure Centre and Littlehampton Tesco's as well as the Angmering Medical Centre, however, Angmering will be expected to help subsidise this route. The trial with or without Angmering's participation begins during the first week of April 2023 and could cost Angmering £12,000. A consultation for the bus route will be included in our annual Community Survey which goes out in November 2022.
- 2) Flood Alleviation Scheme A meeting was held on 19<sup>th</sup> July to discuss this scheme. This was attended by Mr Geoff Gibbs. We are waiting for a report to come through from Ray Drabble (WSCC) regarding this meeting.
- 3) **Dappers Lane** A former member of the Dappers Lane Working Group is in contact with our County Councillor regarding the signs at the junction of Dappers Lane with Arundel Road. Whilst the groundwork has been finished the rest of the work is still to be completed and a date for this is awaited.
