

Planning & Infrastructure Committee Chairs Report 25th October 2022

1. WSCC Governance Committee

Item 19.5 Resolved – That the County Council in October be recommended to approve:

- That County Local Forums (CLF)s be ceased,
- That a report be brought to the Committee on options for briefing local members on highways matters

We await to see what these highways matters are and if they have an impact on the Parish of Angmering.

- 2. SDNP Workshop On Tuesday 18th October I attended the SDNP Workshop at Midhurst. On the Agenda was an update on key projects such as the SDNP Local Plan Review, the Design Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) and Nature Recovery and Climate change action. A very interesting meeting, the first after three years. I asked a question as to whether there were any sites offered in our portion of the park. I was advised that such information couldn't be given at the moment, but it was felt that any large development would be highly unlikely. I also advised them that we were embarking on mapping the cycleways throughout Angmering to which they were pleased, and I asked them who in the Park could be approached for advice and guidance on the cycle paths within the park Alex Pringle.
- **3. Planning Applications** As a result of the continuing number of applications being received for Angmering, I put out to all of you an idea for the way forward for P&I about commenting on applications and the time in which to do this. I am mindful and hopeful that this will also ease the pressure on our Office Staff and enable you to consider the applications more fully.
- 4. **Footpaths** As most of you are aware, I brought to the table the problems (or lack) of footpaths on Dappers Lane, Water Lane, Weavers Hill and High Street with our District Councillor Andy Cooper and asked what ADC were doing about it, the lack of which is a danger, when accessing the site on foot, to our new residents who will occupy the two major developments abutting Water Lane. Councillor Cooper said that ADC were aware of the situation, and he was trying to address this matter. Councillor Urquhart (WSCC) also stated that she has been continually asking for this to be resolved. We can only wait for action but will continue to monitor and pursue the matter as just being aware is not an option when lives are at risk.
- 5. Angmering Advisory Group Councillor Cooper said that he was trying to resurrect the Angmering Advisory Group which was not favourably looked on by some members of ADC. The resurrection of this Group would enable APC to have an input into the planning application process and the ability to express our needs with the larger developments still proposed for Angmering.
- 6. Flood Alleviation Scheme As this is part of P&I's remit, we need to be continually aware as to what is happening. At Full Council a member of the public asked Cllr Urquhart as to what the progress is with the FAS. It was explained that phase one of the scheme was due to start in April 2023 and the options for phase two were still be considered. The member of the public was asked to send in his thoughts and suggestions. Again, as this is important to Angmering and its flooding problems we will monitor and pursue the situation.
- 7. Dappers Lane the former members of the APC Dappers Lane Working Group formed a "Save Dappers Lane Group" and have petitioned for a "No Through Road". This petition has received almost 1000 signatures and the group is now calling for a meeting with our MP, WSCC, ADC and APC.

ADCAAP is planning an assessment of Angmering on Wednesday 19th October anyone wishing to join the panel they will be meeting outside the Lamb at 1400hrs

13 22/088 SOUTH DOWNS NATIONAL PARK

Cllr. Verrinder reported the following:

The SDNP Local Plan Review consultation calling for sites and open green spaces closed on 28th September. Awaiting the result of this consultation – needless to say we need to be aware of any calls made regarding Angmering Park and other land within our national park boundaries.

SDNP Town & Parish Council Workshop – Cllr. Verrinder will be attending this at Midhurst on Tuesday 18th Oct agenda received.

SDNP – Equestrian TAN – Please read as Angmering does have equestrian areas within its boundary and this may affect them. This consultation will be responded to by APC.

14 22/089 COMPLIANCE

Cllr. Verrinder reported that there are reports that construction workers of the BDW – Ecclesden Park development are using the car park by the bridge over the A280. This has been reported direct to BDW and they have assured us they will take action.

15 22/090 APPEALS

16 22/091 CORRESPONDENCE

They are also asking for a meeting with WSCC and Angmering's MP, Andrew Griffiths.

17 22/092 HIGHWAYS MATTERS

Survey - In an effort to understand more about the type of public transport that serves Angmering and the transport needs of the residents of Angmering, APC are currently undertaking a Transport Survey to find out the opinions and needs of the Parish residents. This survey is now live and can be found on the APC website, APC Facebook page and advertised in our office window and noticeboards. So far 100 responses have been submitted.

A259 – The September update has been received and will be posted to our Facebook page. This whole construction is due for completion now in December 2022

WSCC Highways – There is a lot of information regarding highways matters coming from WSCC which may have an effect on Angmering, particularly relating to: -
