1. 1940s Show

I feel as part of the planned celebrations we should put on a Show for the Veterans and other elderly members as I believe some nostalgic entertainment perhaps with a light supper would be most appropriate.

The venue should be inside in case of inclement weather and too much standing around outside may not appeal to our target audience.

The trio who I feel would be most appealing are The Spinettes www.thespinettes.co.uk who can respond to a 1940s theme. They have appeared at the village hall before and were a great success.

I have taken the liberty of emailing them and at present they are available and have requested their performance costs.

Because of their popularity and the common theme across the country, I feel an early decision would be required if we are to secure their attendance.

Please see the response I had from The Spinettes.

The 60-minute performance seems best value but everything depends on whether my suggestion for a 1940s era show with the girls for our veterans / `SOAP's is accepted.

If it was then we would need to decide on the venue - Community Centre / Village Hall and firm up a date. It requires an $\pounds 80$ deposit to book them.


I am pleased to say that The Spinettes are available on all of those dates.



Agenda Item 14, SKATE BOWL REPAIRS

The Angmering Parish Office has been made aware that remedial work is needed to the edge of the Skate Bowl. Please see below for the quote to repair:

1. Site Preparation

Remove existing concrete, area 10m x 0.1m

2. Concrete

Replace with new concrete using rapid hardener to speed up setting. Use a cementone colour to match existing concrete.

3. Site Reinstatement

Once the all works has been completed $\operatorname{Trax} S \operatorname{N}$ Jenks will be responsible for reinstating all areas associated with the contract.

The total cost for replacing existing sunken concrete: £980.00 plus vat.

This quotation includes all materials, machinery and labour.
